

## CATSCRATCH DOOR CUT-OUT TEMPLATE

- 1. FOLD TEMPLATE ON THE DASHED LINE BELOW. USE SCISSORS TO CUT AROUND THE SOLID LINE OF THE TEMPLATE AND REMOVE THE OUTER STRIP.
- 2. DETERMINE THE DESIRED LOCATION OF HOLE-OPENING ON THE BOTTOM OF THE DOOR.
- 3. POSITION TEMPLATE SO THAT THE FOLDED DASH LINE ALIGNS EVENLY WITH THE BOTTOM OF THE DOOR.
- 4. CAREFULLY TRACE THE HOLE OUTLINE ON THE DOOR.
- 5. DARKEN THE HOLE OUTLINE ON THE DOOR SO THAT IT CAN BE EASILY SEEN WHEN SAWING.
- 6. BEFORE SAWING DOUBLE CHECK TO ENSURE THAT YOU TRACED CORRECTLY BY PLACING THE FRAME OVER THE TRACED HOLE OUTLINE (FRAME SHOULD COVER THE HOLE OUTLINE).
- 7. CAREFULLY SAW AROUND THE HOLE OUTLINE. NOTE: YOU MAY WANT TO COVER THE SAW BASE WITH MASKING TAPE TO AVOID SCRATCHING THE DOOR SURFACE.
