- Keep the item on a level ground when installing and during use to avoid tipping or falling. The carriage and wheels should be locked in an equal center of gravity.
- Avoid traveling at a high speed or on bumpy surfaces.
- The bottom basket is not intended to carry pets.
- Do not place hazardous materials in or near the stroller.
- Construction of the stroller will cause static buildup over time.

 Stay grounded and discharge static in a safe location during and after construction of the stroller.

- DON'T use on escalators or stairs. When on escalators or stairs, fold the stroller and carry it with you.
- Before placing your pet inside of the carriage, secure all locks and poles on the stroller.
- DON'T attach your pet's leash to any part of the stroller as it could cause tangling.

NOTES BEFORE AND DURING INSTALLATION

- A SMALL PHILLIPS SCREWDRIVER IS REQUIRED TO INSTALL THE FOOTBOARD.
- EXTRA PRESSURE MIGHT BE NEEDED TO SECURE THE REAR WHEELS IN THEIR PLACE. IF NEEDED, STAND THE STROLLER UPRIGHT AND APPLY HAND PRESSURE FROM THE BASE OF THE CARRIAGE TO LOCK IN THE REAR WHEELS.
- THE PET STROLLER CAN BE FOLDED FOR STORAGE. HOWEVER, ONCE THE WHEELS ARE IN PLACE, THEY CANNOT BE DETACHED.
- THE CUP HOLDER IS OPTIONAL. HOWEVER, TO HAVE THE CUP HOLDER INSTALLED, THE RED HOOK WILL NEED TO BE DETACHED COMPLETELY.
- THE LOCKS AND HOOKS THAT SECURE THE CARRIAGE AND WHEELS ARE POTENTIAL PINCH AREAS. KEEP FREE FINGERS AND TOES AWAY FROM THESE AREAS DURING ASSEMBLY OR STORAGE.




MAINTENANCE: TO PREVENT YOUR PET FROM BEING INJURED BEFORE, DURING OR AFTER USE, CHECK AND MAINTAIN THE STROLLER.




PRE-ASSEMBLY: CHECK FOR ALL PARTS. UNWRAP ALL PLASTIC COVERING FROM THE POLES, WHEELS AND CARRIAGE. DETACH THE RED HOOK FROM THE STROLLER AND UNFOLD THE STROLLER.




FRONT WHEEL: WITH THE STROLLER LYING ON ITS SIDE, INSERT THE FRONT WHEEL. THE FRONT WHEEL HAS AN ARROW ON THE CENTER AXIS, AND THE ARROW SHOULD POINT UPWARD WHEN INSTALLING. THE WHEEL IS SECURED WHEN A SNAP IS HEARD OR FELT. TO LOCK THE WHEEL IN PLACE. SNAP THE RED LATCH UP.




REAR WHEELS: DETACH THE SMALL WIRE FROM ONE SIDE OF THE REAR WHEEL FRAME AND TAKE OUT ONE GASKET. INSERT ONE REAR WHEEL ON THE FRAME, THE BRAKE GROOVES GOING INWARD. INSERT THE GASKET FOLLOWED BY THE SMALL WIRE TO SECURE THE WHEEL. REPEAT FOR THE OTHER WHEEL ON THE OTHER SIDE OF THE FRAME. INSERT THE WHEEL COVER ON EACH OF THE REAR WHEELS. WITH BOTH REAR WHEELS SECURED ON THE FRAME, INSERT THE FRAME ONTO THE BACK OF THE STROLLER. THE RED BRAKES SHOULD BE POINTING BACKWARD.




FOOTBOARD: WITH THE STROLLER LYING ON ITS SIDE, PLACE THE FOOTBOARD ON THE FRONT OF THE STROLLER. SECURE WITH SCREWS AND GASKETS ON EACH OF THE FOUR HOLES.



CUP HOLDER: INSERT THE HOLE ON THE LEFT SIDE OF THE CUP HOLDER TO THE KNOB ON THE LEFT OF THE STROLLER. REPEAT FOR THE RIGHT HOLE FOR THE KNOB ON THE RIGHT SIDE.



BASKET: SNAP THE BUTTONS ON THE BACK OF THE BOTTOM BASKET TO THE BOTTOM POLE. HOOK THE FRONT OF THE BASKET TO THE POLES TO PROP UP THE BASKET.



STORAGE: TO FOLD THE STROLLER, UNZIP THE CARRIAGE. PULL BOTH HOOKS ON THE SIDE OF THE CARRIAGE AT THE SAME TIME. USE THE HANDLE FROM THE STROLLER TO GENTLY PUSH DOWN UNTIL IT IS COMPLETELY FOLDED. USE THE RED HOOK TO LOCK THE STROLLER IN ITS FOLDED POSITION. NEVER LIFT THE STROLLER AFTER DETACHING IT. PETS SHOULD BE OUT OF THE CARRIAGE AND AWAY FROM THE STROLLER WHEN FOLDING.
